



Release and Indemnity Agreement – Dog Run

Dog Run Rules – Hours 10 AM – 6 PM

-  Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by them
-  Owner verifies that their dog (s) have never been certified or deemed to be dangerous to people, other animals or property by any authority having jurisdiction to make such a determination
-  Any dog exhibiting aggressive behavior must be removed immediately
-  Dogs must wear a collar, or harness, at all times and owners must carry leash
-  Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dog (s)
-  No dogs that are sick or in heat are allowed
-  All dogs must have current vaccinations
-  All dogs must be supervised at all times by a person 12 years of age or older while in the dog park. Dogs may not be left unattended in the park.
-  Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult while in the dog park.
-  No alcohol, food or glass allowed
-  Puppies using the park must be at least four months old
-  Dogs should not dig or destroy any property
-  Only registered campers are allowed to use this dog park
-  Dogs should be within view and voice control of owner/handler at all times
-  Parking is not provided in the dog run area. Campers may not cut thru campsites to use the park. Road access is located between C16 and T1 and between T10 and T11.

In consideration of my use or participation in the dog park at Mountain Vista Campground, I agree and acknowledge as follows:

Assumption of Risk: To assume the risks incidental to such participation, which risks may include, among other things, heat or sun related injuries, muscle injuries, broken bones, lacerations and death. I acknowledge that my participation is entirely voluntary.

Release and Indemnity: On my own behalf and on behalf of my heirs, executors, personal representatives, administrators and assigns, to: (1) release and forever discharge the released parties, named below, of and from all liabilities, claims, actions, damage, costs or expenses of any nature whatsoever arising out of or in any way connected with such participation; and (2) indemnify and hold each of the released parties harmless against any and all such liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses, including, but not limited to, all attorney's fees and costs, through and including any appeals. I expressly agree that this release and indemnity agreement includes, without limitation, any claims based on the negligence, action or inaction of any of the released parties, covers bodily injury (including death) and property damage.

Released Parties: The released parties are Mountain Vista Campgrounds Inc, and the officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives selected by Mountain Vista Campgrounds Inc.

Authorization for Medical Treatment: I hereby authorize medical treatment for myself, at my cost, if the need arises, however I acknowledge that the released parties shall have no duty, obligation or liability arising out of the provision of, or failure to provide medical treatment.

Governing Law, Venue: This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Pennsylvania, and any legal action relating to or arising out of this agreement shall be commenced exclusively in Monroe County, PA.

Owner specifically represents to Mountain Vista Campground that to the best of the owner's knowledge the animal has not been exposed to rabies or distemper within a 30 day period prior to boarding.

Owner agrees that if the animal is involved in an incident involving a bite and current rabies vaccination cannot be verified, it may be necessary to quarantine the animal, subject to the discretion of the local health authority.

I have read the above and confirm my pet(s) meet(s) the guidelines listed above and agree to abide by all above conditions relating to the use of pet facilities and Mountain Vista Campground.
